



Reaching the Region By Air

Trat Airport, owned and operated by Bangkok Airways, is located on the mainland near to Laem Ngop. At the moment flights operate to and from Bangkok taking about 40 minutes.

Until October 28th there will two flights a day between Bangkok and Trat departing at 9.00 and 16.10. Return flights leave at 9.50 and 17.20.

From October 28th there will three daily flights to Trat from Bangkok leaving at 08.30, 14.40 and at 17.00. Flights back to Bangkok from Trat leave at 10.00, 16.10 and 18.30.

The Trat office of Bangkok Airways can be reached on 039 525 777 and the number of the airport is 039 525 767-8.

By Car

Eastern Thailand and its islands can be easily reached by road and three regular car ferries operate to Koh Chang.


There are two main driving routes from Bangkok, both around 310km long.

The first route is to take Highway 3, the Bangna - Trat road. There is a quicker elevated tollway running above Highway 3. Continue until the Chonburi Bypass and here turn off onto Highway 344. Follow this road past Ban Bung and when you reach the Klaeng Crossroads turn back onto highway 3 and continue on towards Trat.

Alternatively you can leave Bangkok on the Motorway that is a continuation of the Rama IX, Srinikarin road. This road goes onwards and meets highway 344 where you can continue to Trat as detailed above.


To avoid Trat and go directly to the ferry departure points turn right onto the well-signposted Laem Ngop road about 20km outside Trat.

Driving from Pattaya take Highway 36 which

joins Highway 3 heading towards Trat shortly after Rayong.

Private transfers to and from the island can be arranged with Evolution Tour on 089 603 9642.

Buses From Bangkok

Minibus and full sized bus services pick up from guesthouses around Khao San Road and other Bangkok locations on request and travel directly to ferry departure points at Laem Ngop. Bookings can be made from any of the scores of travel agents in this area. The buses leave at 7-8am taking 5-6 hours and cost around 180-250B for a single trip including ferry crossing. Minibuses return to Bangkok at 11am every day from Laem Ngop.

Frequent buses also leave for Trat from the Eastern Bus Terminal (Ekamai) and the Northern Bus Terminal (Mor Chit). Ekamai is located on the route of the Bangkok Skytrain whilst Morchit is slightly closer to Khao San road. The journey takes 4-6 hours & costs around 220 Baht.

Another bus service runs from Ekamai direct to the departure point of the Koh Chang ferry in Laem Ngop. This service costs 200 Baht and saves time since you don't need to get a taxi from Trat to the ferry.

Also there is a bus service that departs from the ferry port at Ao Thammachat. Buses leave for Ekamai and also go direct to Khao San Road. The cost is 300 baht including the ferry crossing and buses leave at 11am.

Return buses now leave from Trat's new bus station, about 1km out of town (See the Trat Map). Get a taxi to drop you off there. Departure times for Tanakawee and Cherd Chai buses are listed below.

Buses From Pattava/Koh Samet

Daily minibus services operate from Pattaya via Ban Pae (ferry port for Koh Samet) to the ferry departure point at Laem Ngop. The cost is around 400B from Pattaya or 300B from Ban Pae and the journey takes 4 or 2.5 hours respectively.

Going to Laem Ngop the service leaves Pattaya at 8am. It picks up in Ban Pae at 11am. A return service leaves Laem Ngop at 1pm daily.

Public buses leave for Pattaya from Tanakawee road in Trat at 05.00, 09.30, 12.00 and 15.00 daily. The trip costs 160B and takes at least 5 hours.

To Cambodia

There is a daily minibus from Laem Ngop direct to Siem Reap in Cambodia. This is great if you want to head straight up to the temples at Angkor Wat. The bus leaves at 10.30am and arrives in Siem Reap around 7.00pm. The cost is 1,000-1,300 Baht depending on the season. Visas at the border are 1,200 Baht. Book at travel agents in Koh Chang or contact Kiatiphol Tour on 039 597 181. You can also cross over the border into Cambodia at Hat Lek. The opening hours of this border are 7am to 9pm. Minibuses to the border leave from the new bus station in Trat every 45 minutes (see map of Trat) and take about one hour to reach the border.

One month Cambodian visas (1,200B) can be obtained at the border. Take a passport photo or

you will be charged another 100 Baht. Better still, get the visa in Bangkok and save on the mysterious extra 'charges' imposed at the border.

There is also a road offering an overland route into Cambodia. You can take a daily minibus from outside the Cambodian immigration office to either Phnom Penh or Sihanoukville. Both minibuses leave at 9am. The cost is 650B (\$15 US) to Phnom Penh or 550 B (\$13 US) to Sihanoukville. Buy your ticket in Koh Chang or Trat.

Alternatively onward journeys into Cambodia are through Sihanoukville via ferry to/from Koh Kong. The boat trip costs 600B and takes around 4 hours. Since the Sihanoukville boat leaves Koh Kong at 8am you will need to spend the night in Koh Kong. To get there take a motorcycle or taxi to Koh Kong for around 50B a head. Expect to be overcharged and agree the cost before you leave.

From Cambodia

Minibuses run from Sihanoukville and Phnom Penh to the Thai border at 7.30am daily. Ask at your guesthouse or hotel for details.


Boat departures from Sihanoukville to Koh Kong are at 12pm each day. On arrival at Koh Kong either stay the night or get a taxi or motorcycle to the Thai border before the 5pm close if you arrive with enough time to spare. More hazardous speedboats to the border operate from the ferry immigration stop before Koh Kong. These are not recommended in wavy conditions.

One month Thai visas can be obtained for free at the border. After crossing to Thailand a regular 100B minibus to Trat leaves every 45 minutes and takes just over an hour.

Boats To The Islands

Koh Chang, Koh Wai, Koh Maak and Koh Kham can be reached by ferry from the nearby port of Laem Ngop. To get there from Trat take a share Taxi (see Trat map) for 40B or, if you don't want to wait until it fills up, hire a full taxi for 150B.

A regular ferry service goes to Koh Chang year round. However, services to the other islands can be less frequent or stop altogether during

the June to October wet season. Many resorts on these islands close during the rains anyway so enquire before you travel there at that time of year.

There is a new direct taxi service from Trat to the Eastern side of Koh Chang. If you are going to Salak Phet or any of the other places on the Eastern side of the island this is a very convenient way to get there. Taxis leave from the narrow road behind Trat Department Store three times a day at 10am, Mid-day and 3pm. Return taxis leave Salak Phet at 5am, 6am and 8am so set your alarm clocks.

Koh Chang

Passenger ferries leave the main pier in Laem Ngop hourly from 6am to 6pm for Dan Kao in Koh Chang. The cost is around 50-60B and the journey takes an hour.

Two car ferry firms operate from Ao Thammachat a short way up the coast from Laem Ngop. They charge about 80 Baht one way for a car and run hourly from 7am to 7pm daily. They also carry foot passengers (80-90B) and are linked to Trat & Laem Ngop by taxis. Crossings take from 25 to 50 minutes.

On arrival share taxis wait to take passengers to the various beaches. White Sands Beach (Hat Sai Khao) is 40B, Klong Phrao is 50B, Kai Bae 60B and Hat Ta Nam (Lonely Beach) costs 80B. A taxi goes to Bang Bao once daily at 4pm.

Koh Maak & Koh Kham

A daily ferry to Koh Maak & Koh Kham leaves Laem Ngop at 3pm taking three hours.

Inter Island Hopper runs a daily service to these islands from Bang Bao on Koh Chang. Call 081 865 0610 for details.

Bang Bao Boat also offer a daily service to these islands. Contact 087 054 4300.

Koh Kood

With the building of new resorts on Koh Kood boat services going there have improved.

A ferry run by War Choke Wuttichai leaves for Koh Kood from Dan Khao, 5km out of Trat. Ask

at your guesthouse or get a Trat car or motorbike taxi to get you there. This ferry departs for Koh Kood at 10am on Tuesdays and Fridays. A return service leaves from Khlong Mat pier on Koh Kood at 10am on Sundays and Thursdays. The cost is 200B. Call 089 825 2389 - Thai language only.

Inter Island Hopper runs a regular service from Koh Chang, Koh Wai and Koh Maak to Koh Kood. The Boat departs on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays. Contact 081 865 0610.

Koh Wai

A daily ferry to Koh Wai leaves Laem Ngop at 3pm taking 2.5 hours. Island Hopper run a daily boat from Bang Bao on Koh Chang call 081 865 0610.

Bang Bao Boat also offer a daily service to Koh Wai. Contact 087 054 4300.

Other Islands

A host of boat trips are available from Koh Chang to some of the other islands. Thai Fun



offer transport to the other islands from White Sand Beach. Travel between Koh Chang, Koh Rayang, Koh Maak, Koh Wai and Koh Kood can also be arranged with these tours. See the activities section of the guide for details of these boat services.

Getting Around

On Koh Chang hourly share taxis run between all the beaches as far as Lonely Beach and the

ferry terminals from 6am until late evening. They can be flagged down anywhere and used to travel around the island. If you are planning to return to your hotel late at night don't rely on the taxis since evening services are a bit erratic. Either book a taxi yourself or take advantage of the transport services that are increasingly being offered by many of the hotels, bars and restaurants on the island.

Alternatively cars, motorcycles and bicycles can be hired from many hire firms and resorts. Cowboy in Chai Chet rent a range of Cars and Bikes. They can be contacted on 081 520 0339. Roads are of good quality but there are some dangerous hill sections. If you are an inexperienced motorcycle rider then think carefully before hiring a motorbike. Every year the island has quite a few road deaths and many visitors have their trip spoiled by a motorcycle accident. If you don't wear a helmet the local police will be waiting to fine you.

Leaving Koh Chang

When leaving the island from any of the main beaches wait anywhere on the road about 45 minutes before ferry departure and share taxis will stop and pick you up as they pass taking you to the ferry departure point. If you are travelling to Trat airport then you can book a minibus that will take you directly to the airport. Book this on 039 525 776.

NB. Changes to Thai Mobile Phone Numbers

From the start of September Thailand is making changes to all mobile phone numbers in the country to enable the issuing of more new phone numbers. All Mobile phone numbers will change to include an '8' as the second digit. In other words the number 01-919-8219 will now become 081-919-8219. Mobile phone companies say that you will be able to use the old number until the end of November but if you are experiencing any problems then make the change and add the extra eight. We have listed all mobile numbers in this issue as the new numbers. In the event of any connection problems then drop the eight and try the old number. Note that these changes apply to mobile phones only. Land-line numbers remain at nine digits. All numbers beginning 039 in the guide are Trat land-line numbers and will not change. Simplicity itself!

Useful Information

Climate

Southeast Thailand has two seasons, a dry period that runs from November to May and a wet season from June to October. Temperatures are coolest from November to December with daily maximums averaging around 30C. Just before the wet season this can rise to the high thirties.

It can rain heavily in the wet season but rainfall is by no means constant. Indeed sunny days are still common. Many resorts on the outer islands close during the rains but all the resorts and facilities on Koh Chang remain open and this can be a good time to visit for those seeking a quieter holiday.

The busiest time for visitors to the region is December to April.

There is a Tourist authority of Thailand (TAT) office in Laem Ngop. Phone - 039-597-255.

Information on Koh Chang National Park can be obtained from the National Parks offices in Laem Ngop (Tel. - 039-538-100) or from the office in Koh Chang (see map).

Health & Medical Facilities

Koh Chang International Clinic, part of the Bangkok Hospital group, (039-551-555 or www. kohchanginterclinic.com) is located on White Sands Beach. They are open 24 hours a day.

P.P.Clinic opposite Amari resort in Klong Prao provide general medical services from a qualified surgeon as well as a range of plastic surgery treatments. Contact them on 039-557-211 from 9am to 8pm or on 085-222-3935, 24 hours a day.

There is a small hospital in Koh Chang just south of where the mainland ferry arrives (Phone - 039 521 657). Khlong Son, Kai Bae, Khlong Prao and Bang Bao also have small clinics.

Koh Chang Pharmacy in White Sand Beach and Kai Bae has a wide range of medicines and a pharmacist with over 20 years experience and perfect English. They offer wound dressing and provide insurance receipts. Call 081 952 3583.





pital, a private institution, which has excellent facilities and is recommended in the event of any major accidents or emergencies (039-532-735) and Trad Hospital (039-511-040/1).

The region has Malaria although cases are very rare. It is more of a risk in the monsoon. Take the

usual precautions.

Increasingly people are using their holidays in Thailand to get dental work done. Dentists here are as good as in the rest of the world and charge a fraction of the prices in Europe and the US. Now you can use the Koh Chang Dental Centre or Baan More Fun Dentist in Trat to get your teeth healthy. Contacts are 086-320-0702 and 039-557-235.

Animal Health services are available on Koh Chang, Call 089-042-2347 for information.

Emergencies

In the event of a medical emergency after normal ferry hours contact Ko Chang International Clinic on call centre on 1719 or Bangkok Trat Hospital on 039-532-735. They arrange for emergency evacuation by boat and ambulance to Trat.

The main police station on Koh Chang is at Dan Mai. They can be contacted on 039-586-191 and 039-586-098. There are also police stations in White Sands Beach and in Kai Bae. Alternatively the Tourist Police can be contacted on 1155.

Banks

Koh Chang now has ATMs all over the place so withdrawing cash is no problem. There are also several banks and foreign exchange offices at the main beaches.

There are many banks in Trat with ATMs. Various hotels and guesthouses will change both traveller's cheques and cash but the rates offered are lower than the banks. Many resorts and restaurants also accept credit card payments.

Communications

Trat has several small Internet cafes and guesthouses that charge 1B per minute for E-mail. Koh Chang and Koh Maak have Internet access from 1B per minute via satellite or phone connections. See the maps for locations.

If you have been to Koh Chang before note that the island's Post Office, which used to be on White Sand Beach has moved to a new, larger building, just over the hill at Pearl Beach.

Postage rates are reasonable. A small postcard

Koh Chang island lies in the centre of a Marine national park of 47 different tropical jungle islands. It is rightly held to be the crowning beauty of Thailand's Eastern coast. to any country is 12B and large postcards are 15B. Air-mail letters start at 14 Baht and increase depending on destination and size. The post office will not send letters with stamps of insufficient value so it is best to get them weighed and stamped in the post office to be sure that they will be delivered.

Local and national phone calls can be made at several of the resorts and businesses on the island (10B/min local or 40B/min international are typical prices). There are international phone terminals on most of the main beaches.

There is also a Telecommunications office in Trat that is open from 7am to 10pm.

Immigration

The regional immigration office is located at Laem Ngop. The office has recently moved from its old location. It is now located about 1km outside Laem Ngop on the left side of the main road heading towards Trat. They can deal with visa extensions and other queries here. If you have a 30 Day Visa for Thailand you can extend this for up to 10 days. You can also get a one month extension on a two month visa. These extensions cost 1,900 Baht each. Phone 039-597-261.






Loy Kratong - Festival

Diving & Snorkelling

There are some excellent diving and snorkelling opportunities around Koh Chang and the region is rapidly developing into a major centre of diving in Thailand.

The diving in the area is primarily at reasonably shallow depths with good reefs located at 5 to 25 metres. Visibility can reach 30m but is variable. You can dive year round but the best time is between October and the end of May since rougher seas during the rainy season can reduce visibility or make it difficult to reach the dive sites. However there are calmer periods in the rainy season when diving conditions are OK.

There are impressive reefs in the area with a variety of soft and hard corals including Massive, Columnar and Stagshorn Corals. These support a range of tropical reef life including Blue Tipped Rays, Moray Eels, Trigger Fish, Grouper and Batfish. Turtles can


be spotted and Whale Sharks are also seen in the area from time to time.

There are a series of dive sites offering good diving at 5-18m around the seamounts and small islands to the West of Koh Chang, These include Koh Man Nok and Hin Sam Sao.

The deeper dive sites are located off some of the islands and seamounts to the South of the Archipelago, Hin Luk Bat has a lot of good







coral and some good swim-throughs. Hin Raap is a deeper rocky site with good soft corals. Other good sites lie off Koh Rang.

Koh Chang has quite a few dive operations. On White Sands Beach you can choose from White Sand Dive Centre, Koh Chang Divers and The Wing Dive Center. Waterworld Diving, Scandinavian Diving Center, Eco-Divers and Dolphin Divers are located in Klong Prao. Seahorse Divers are based in Kai Bae. Ploy Scuba Diving, Scubadive-thailand.com, B.B. Divers and The Dive Adventure operate from Bang Bao village. You can book your diving by visiting the offices of the dive shops or from resorts and travel agencies on the island.

The price for a two-day Discover Scuba course is 3,500B whilst full PADI certification costs around 11,000B. Pleasure dives cost 2,200-2,400B, depending on site, for two dives with lunch. All other PADI courses are also available.


Koh Chang Dive Supply is a large retailer of all kinds of Diving equipment. They also offer a full repair and servicing workshop for all sorts of Scuba equipment. Their office is located between White Sand Beach and Chai Chet (Tel. 039-551-518).

Whilst the beaches of Koh Chang themselves offer little opportunity for snorkelling other islands in the chain can be reached by boat trips and there is some excellent shallow reef for snorkelling at these sites. Additionally there are a few good snorkelling sites on Koh Chang. The rocky shorelines at Hat Kai Mook and Bang Bao Cliff Cottages offer some good snorkelling.

Additionally most of the dive shops will take snorkellers on their boats. Contact them for prices and details.

Swimming

It is generally fine to swim off all of Koh Chang's beaches. In the high season conditions

are calm and safe and the gradual slope of the beaches makes for good swimming conditions

Note, however, that during the rainy season heavy seas with rip tides can develop and people drown every year. Basically, don't swim beyond your abilities and if the sea looks dangerous it probably is so stay out of the water when it's too rough.

Other Watersports

Ban Kwan Chang Elephant Camp also offer guided kayak tours.

Salak Kok Kayak Station offer Kayak hire and guided wildlife kayak tours around the sheltered mangrove-forested Salak Kok bay on the Eastern side of Koh Chang. They are concerned with preserving the local mangrove ecosystem and you are welcome to help with mangrove planting and other environmental preservation activities. Contact them on 081-

You can rent canoes from many places on the busier beaches. They cost 100-200 Baht per hour.

Beaches

The main beaches on Koh Chang are all on the west coast and are, from North to South, Hat Sai Khao (White Sands Beach), Klong Prao, Kai Bae and Hat Ta Nam (Lonely Beach).

There is also a beach past the village of Bang Bao in the southwest of the island and a couple of others including Long Beach in the far southeast which now has road access.

All of the beaches are in attractive settings, with accommodation and facilities. White Sands Beach has the most development and a wide range of dining and entertainment is available. Klong Prao and Kai Bae have fewer



Villages

In addition to settlements at the beaches mentioned previously there are several villages on the island that are worth a visit.

Klong Son is the first village reached on the drive to the beaches from the ferry arrival points. Parts of the village are built over the sea in an attractive bay.

Bang Bao is another photogenic village built out into the bay on stilts. There are several small restaurants noted for their excellent fresh seafood and there are several guest houses and rooms for rent available.

In the far southeast of the island, a long way from the most developed areas and resorts is the village of Salak Phet, also noted for good seafood. A recent initiative has been the introduction of home stay accommodation in Bang Bao and Salak Phet. Enquire there for accommodation possibilities.





There is a recently completed Mangrove Walkway near to Salak Kok on the East of the island. You can take a 15 minute stroll through the mangrove forest on a raised walkway that is sadly made entirely out of concrete.


Orchid Gardens is set in an attractively landscaped garden close to Ao Sapparot where the ferry docks. They grow beautiful orchids in their gardens and you're welcome to come and take a stroll. Orchids are also available for sale here.

Wildlife

Most of Koh Chang is covered in rain fores that has been largely undisturbed due to the mountainous terrain of the island. There are also good examples of mangrove fores ecosystems where the island's numerou streams meet the sea. Marine National Parl status was awarded to the island chain in 198; in an effort to preserve the exceptional land and marine environment.

The forests of the island support a large range of wildlife. A survey conducted for Thailand's National Park Service in 1997, recorded 29 different species of mammal or Koh Chang, These included the Stump-Tailed Macaque, Barking Deer, Wild Pig, Javan Mongoose and Silvered Langur.





Additionally the survey noted 42 different species of amphibians and reptiles. Snakes that inhabit Koh Chang include the Python, Rat Snake and King Cobra. Malayan Mud Turtles, Monitor Lizards and the ubiquitous Gecko are also found on the island. There are also a variety of very vocal frogs. The aptly named Koh Chang Frog is a species unique to the islands.

Waterfalls




Elephant Trekkina

Other Islands

Koh Maak

This is an attractive, low-lying island 16 square kilometres in size. Since there are few hills the island is widely cultivated with coconut and rubber plantations.

The population is only around 500 so there is little infrastructure outside the resorts. Electricity has recently become available around the clock.

See the transport section for details of the various ferries to the island that operate from the mainland. Alternatively some of the Koh Chang boat trip services can drop you off on the island. Enquire for details.

Representatives from the resorts meet the ferry and offer free pick up and drop off to visitors.

There are pretty beaches in the bays to the northwest and southwest of the island and this is where most of the resorts are located.


Diving on the island is offered by Ploy Scuba Diving from Panorama resort to the south of the island and also now from Monkey Island resort.

You can access E-mail at Koh Mak Resort or do so while admiring the great view from Ko Mak Villa.

Three smaller islands off Koh Maak have resorts and can be reached fairly easily from Koh Maak itself. They are Koh Kham, Koh Rayang Nok and Koh Kra Dad. A daily boat goes to Koh Rayang Nok from Holiday Beach resort at 10am and returns at 4pm. Free transit to Koh Maak is provided by the resort. To arrange transport to the other islands contact the resorts or enquire on Koh Maak.

Koh Wai

Koh Wai is a small crescent shaped island with two small, pleasant beaches. There are two resorts on the island with simple hut accommodation. There is some good snorkelling on the shallow reefs off the beach or

you can try diving with BB Divers who have recently opened an office here. The lack of development makes the island an ideal place for a peaceful beach trip and it's a good place to kick back after some strenuous travelling.

Other Islands

Several of the other islands in the Koh Chang group have resorts that cater largely to package tourism. Koh Lao Ya is actually two separate islands linked by a bridge and has an attractive resort. Consult travel agents for information on the other islands.

Koh Kood

Koh Kood is the second largest and southernmost island in the Koh Chang archipelago. Its topography is similar to that of Koh Chang. It is also mountainous and largely covered in rain forest. The highest hill on Koh Kood, at 315 metres, is Khao Phaentee in the southeast of the island.

Another significant scenic feature is Klong Chao waterfall. The waterfall itself is not particularly high but falls into a huge plunge pool in a very beautiful jungle setting, a good place for a cooling swim. Various tours in Koh Maak offer trips to the waterfall or try Island Hopper in Koh Chang. Alternatively enquire on Koh Chang to book a boat tour privately.

The sea here is extremely clear and a brilliant blue colour. This makes the many beaches that run down the West coast of the island extremely pleasant places to be. Also there are some excellent corals at shallow depths on many of the beaches

Despite the fact that Koh Kood is Thailand's fourth biggest island the population is estimated to be only 1,500. Infrastructure is improving and there is now a decent road between many points of interest on the island but the resorts to the extreme north and south of the island are still only accessible by boat. There is also a small hospital.

The largest settlement is the fishing village of Ao Salat in the northeast. This is worth a visit just to see the wide range of seafood brought in and sold on the rickety wooden

Unfortunately there isn't yet any organised public transport on the island. In fact there aren't many vehicles at all. If you want to have a look around ask at your resort to see if you can hire a motorbike or get a car to take you around. Alternatively you might be able to get around in a motor boat or canoe.

Traditionally the resorts on the island have been luxury developments catering mainly to Thai package tourism. Transport to these resorts is arranged as part of the package deal

There are now, however, some new low and medium end options which cater more to foreign visitors. Rooms at these places start at 300B.

The easiest way to reach the island independently is with Koh Kood Seatrans leaving from Laem Ngop and Koh Chang or by taking the local ferry from Dan Khao close to Trat (see transport section).

If you want a beautiful sandy beach virtually to yourself and don't expect anything by way of nightlife other than listening to the waves lap then this is the place for you. If you expect a party you will be disappointed but if peace and quiet is your thing then Koh Kood is a good choice of destination. The water around Koh Kood is famed for its blueness and clarity and you can find some pretty good corals off the beaches if you like to snorkel. You can dive off Koh Kood with Ploy Scuba Diving in Ao Salat and next to Bai Kood Shambala.



Trat & The Mainland



Trat

The small town of Trat is the administrative and trading centre of Trat province. It is located 20km away from Laem Ngop, the departure point for passenger ferries to the islands. Trat has a population of 20,000 but bustles with activity due to the numerous local markets (see map above).

There is an open-air market on the main street - Thanon Sukhumvit - that offers interesting Thai food and drinks late into the night. There is also a large covered day market selling all manner of foods and household goods.

Good things to shop for include the huge

range of fruits that are available year round, many of which you may not have seen before. Trat province is famous for the Rakham which is a delicious sweet fruit that looks a bit like a strawberry. Or there is the Durian with its spiky shell, pungent smell and unique love-it-or-hate-it flavour. Try whatever looks interesting.

You can also buy good fresh seafood and vegetables in the market.

Local handicrafts include elaborately woven wicker products, especially hats. These can be found in Ban Nam Chieo, a village between Trat and Laem Ngop.

Trat & The Mainland

Trat Department Store on the main street is also a good place for shopping.

Wat Buppharam is a 17th Century temple with some interesting architecture. It lies 2km out of town (see map). There are several other Temples scattered around the town centre.

Trat has good medical, communication, financial and other facilities. Locations are shown on the map on the previous page.

There are a multitude of local Thai restaurants around the town. Additionally Joy's Pizza, Kruarimkol and Sea House all do good food.

There is a guesthouse area just south of the town centre with many backpacker style guesthouses and accompanying restaurants, internet cases etc. There is little to choose between the different guesthouses that all offer clean and inexpensive rooms together with good information and a friendly welcome.

The town has some interesting evening entertainment. A good spot is Somkanay, a bar with live Thai music every night. The night market is a good place to sit with a meal or drink and watch the action.

You can find many other small restaurants and bars scattered around the town centre.

About 10 minutes from the centre is an attractive reservoir that is a pleasant spot for an afternoon stroll. There are several restaurants on the shoreside. Ra Bieng Mai restaurant comes highly recommended.

Laem Ngop

Laem Ngop is a fishing village on the coast and is the departure point for passenger ferries to Koh Chang and the other islands.

Places worthy of note are the Immigration office and the Tourist Authority of Thailand office.

By the ferry pier there is a large monument commemorating two Thai boats that were sunk in a naval battle of 1942 off Koh Chang in which Thai forces repelled the French Navy.

Bo Rai

This town is in the foothills of the mountains that comprise the Cambodian border. It was originally a centre of Ruby mining and you can still visit the nearby ruby market.

There is excellent trekking in the mountains and an attractive waterfall nearby.



Mainland Beaches

There is a long coastal section of Trat province heading southeast towards the Cambodian border.

Whilst this area is not much visited by foreign tourists there are a string of beaches with a few accommodation options that are reputedly very attractive.

Heading away from Trat on highway 318 these beaches include Sai Ngern Beach, Sai Kieow Beach, Tap Tim Beach, Mai Root Beach and Ban Chuen Beach.

Klong Yai

This small fishing town is the last town on the road to the Cambodian border at Hat Lek. It is the closest mainland town to Koh Kood and whilst there is, as yet, no regular ferry service you may be able to ask around and find a boat on its way to the island.

Suvarnabhumi Airport

If everything goes as planned by the Thai Government's Transport Ministry then you have already flown into the country through Suvarnabhumi, Bangkok's new airport. As this magazine went to press the opening of the airport was set at September 28th, 2006. After many postponements it looks like it may actually open this time as well.

White Sands Publications tried out the first commercial flight from Trat to the new airport on the official testing date of July 29th. And everything went fine. The plane landed smoothly on the enormous, crack-free runway and we were safely shuttled and eventually deposited in the world's largest airport terminal. This huge terminal covers over half a million square meters and is a many-armed modernist beast of glass, concrete and metal. It looks quite good really in a giant centipede sort of way.



The airport is located about 25 kilometres east of Bangkok. The name Suvarnabhumi (pronounced su-wan-na-poom) which

From the opening date all domestic and international flights into Bangkok will arrive here. Transport into the city will, in theory at least be trouble-free, using a new airport link train that will whisk passengers into town in 15 minutes. Sadly this service won't open for at least a year after the airport opens. In the interim a taxi ride into the city will be necessary. Whilst less convenient this is still pretty quick.

■ Thai Food

Thailand has one of the great world cuisines. While you're here you should sample some of the delicious food available. Even though the Thais have only had chillies for four hundred years or so they are one of the key ingredients in Thai food. But if you don't like spicy food don't worry; the Thai chefs on Koh Chang are used to making dishes milder on request and there are also plenty of Thai dishes which aren't too spicy.

Whilst the food is great you may not be familiar with some of the names of the dishes and translations can sometimes be a little confusing. One local restaurant used to have "Fish in That Sauce" on their menu. So to help you to explore Thal food while you are here in Koh Chang the following is a very brief introduction to some Thai dishes you may want to sample. With most meals you can usually choose which meat or seafood you want. Chicken is Gai, Pork is Moo, Beef is Neu-a, Prawn is Goong, Fish is Pia, Squid is Pia Meuk and Vegelable is Pak. Enloy!

Simple Dishes

That stople dishes are simple and nourishing and usually revolve around rice or noodles.

Gang Panana

This is one of the famous Thai curries. This dish has a rich creamy sauce thickened by coconut milk. You can purchase the curry pastes in most large supermarkets back home, or why not take some home with you as a souvenir of your holiday in Thailand?

Serve with plain boiled rice or as part of a larger Thai meal.

Ingredients

Meat	100gms
Carrot thinly sliced	Quarter
Green Beans: 2cm pieces	50gms
Large Red Chilli chopped	Quarter or to taste
4- 6 Kaffir Lime Leaves torn	into large pieces
Oil for frying	2 Tablespoons
Prik Gang Curry Paste	Teaspoon
Prik Gang Panang Paste	Half tablespoon
Coconut Milk	10-20 millilitres

Preparation

Heat the oil in a wok and add the meat together with the two chilli pastes and fry over a medium heat for about three minutes or until the meat begins to brown.

Now add the Green Beans, Chilli, Carrots and Lime Leaves and fry for a minute or two (longer if you prefer the vegetables to be softer).

Add a little water and fry for two more minutes.

Next add the Coconut Milk, Oyster Sauce, Nam Pla, sugar and a little water and boil at a higher heat for about two minutes.

Serve as part of a Thai meal or on its own with rice. A fried egg thrown on top is delicious if vour diet allows it.

Buying Land and Properties in Thailand

The laws and regulations regarding purchase of land and properties can be confusing to a foreign investor. The following are a few ideas to get you started in figuring out how things work over here. Remember that this is only a very broad overview and you should do further research.

Legal Representation

Basically the best thing that you can do is get a good lawyer with experience in helping foreign investors purchase property. What may seem a high fee in the short term can save you a fortune and a lot of trouble later on. We recommend that you consult a legal firm in Bangkok or Pattaya: there are many in Pattaya who specialise in foreign real estate deals. Since they have a lot of experience they are probably a good choice. Alternatively if you are dealing with a good real estate agency they should be able to recommend good legal representation to you.

Foreign Ownership of Thai Land

Foreign nationals can purchase and own apartments entirely in their own name. In the case of land, however, they need to establish a Thai company that will purchase and possess the land. By law they must remain a minority shareholder in this company but in reality they can exercise sole control over the company through a variety of directorship appointment clauses and different types of shares and voting rights.

The individual investor can then lease the land and buildings from the controlling company as a further level of protection.

Types of Land Title Chanote

The best and most secure of Thai land title deeds. The boundary markers of this land are measured by GPS and it provides a certificate of ownership of the land.

Nor Sor Sam Gor

The boundaries of land with this title deed are still fairly clear, being defined with reference to aerial surveys.

Nor Sor Sam

The land boundaries for Nor Sor Sam are defined relative to those of neighbouring plots and errors are common. However it is still an assured title of land possession.

Por Bor Tor/Sor Kor

These are effectively squatters land titles. Whilst a lot of land with these title deeds on Koh Chang has in fact been developed the development is all, strictly speaking, illegal. NB - Occasionally it is possible to apply to have one of these less secure forms of land title upgraded to Chanote. In practice this can take years and may never happen. If someone tells you that 'their' land will be upgraded then wait until it has been and you have seen all the paperwork before going any further. It is not uncommon for the ownership of land with Por Bor Tor or Sor Kor title to be disputed. It is probably best to only consider land with Chanote, Nor Sor Sam Gor or, at a pinch, Nor Sor Sam land title.

Thai Land Measures

In Thailand Land is measured in Rai, Ngan and Wah which are:

1 Rai	=	1,600 sq.m
1 Ngan	=	400 sq.m
1 Wah	=	4 sq.m

1 Acre	=	2.53 Rai
1 Hectare	=	6.25 Rai
